I. Model prayer for prophetic intercession Matt.6:9

A. Prophetic intercession is bringing the will and the kingdom of God into earth, just the way it is in heaven.

B. The Mediator of God the Father, Jesus, came to bring earth and heaven together: the Ministry of Reconciliation.

C. Prophetic intercession happens when a person presents himself as a living sacrifice in prayer in order to cause the will and kingdom of the Lord to be manifested or made apparent in a person, nation or circumstance; in other words, enabling God to conceive Himself in that thing.

D. David's band of mighty men understood the times to know what Israel should do.
1 Chron. 12:32.

E. Ezekiel the Prophet—Ezekiel Chapter 1: Ezekiel saw a vision of what was happening in heaven. To bring His will into earth as it is in heaven, we must see into that heavenly realm.

F. Ezekiel the priest. Prophetic intercessors must SEE what is going on in heaven but also partner with God to bring it into the earth.

III. Ezekiel's vision-- the fire, the whirlwind, the living creatures, all were types and shadows and manifestations of the very Spirit of God Himself. The faces of the living creatures are the manifestation of the character and nature of Christ.

IV. The "Burden" of Ezekiel. We receive the wine of His Presence so that we can receive the weight of His glory so that we can carry it to the nations, standing in the gap as mediators and intercessors, bringing heaven and earth together as one.

VI. Prophetic Intercessor: Summary of Definitions

1. One who stands in the gap between God's righteous judgment and the need for mercy (Eze.13:4-5).
2. One who brings the gap between God's purity and man's weakness and frailty together so that the strength and character of the Lord can flow unhindered into the situation, vine into branches.
3. One willing to sacrifice time and energy on behalf of someone else, being willing above all to plead for mercy instead of the usual human reactions of criticism and judgment.
4. One who allows God through them to bring justice where there is none (Isa. 59:15-16).

5. Watchman on the wall of God's house, sounding the alarm and reminding the Lord of His righteous judgments and covenant and His wonderful promises to His people (Isa. 62:6-7).

6. One who SEES into the heavenly realms while others are often sleeping. Watchmen expend themselves, giving themselves and the Lord no rest until His people are established as a praise in the earth.

7. One who is a partner with God in the working out of His purposes for these last days in His people. The kingdom of God suffereth violence and the violent take it by force (Matt. 11:12).

8. One willing to come both as Priest (drew near to Lord on behalf of people) and Prophet (saw the burden of Lord and came to people on behalf of Lord).

9. Ones who invade the realm of the miraculous possessing it as the land of promise, and bringing it into manifestation in the earth-- in earth as it is in heaven, releasing the missiles of signs and wonders to disperse the ravages of darkness with the Light of the World.
